- Educationally positions the case studies between completion of the mainly theoretical qualification in podiatric therapeutics and prior to commencing the Board's requirement for supervised practice for ESM as set out in the Board's registration standards for ESM

- Consideration of key prescribing resources, such as the National Prescribing Service (NPS) *Competencies Required to Prescribe Medicines* (2012), the *Australian Medicines Handbook* (2014) and the *Therapeutics Guidelines* (various).
